To install the stairlift, a track is fastened on brackets to the stairs for support, keeping the rails of the stairlift well-elevated from the stairs. Ideally, the brackets are fastened to the stair treads with 4 screws per bracket and every 3-4 stair rise to ensure there is no damage to the banister or walls surrounding the staircase.

Straight stair lifts can carry heavier loads than curved stair lifts, which operate on a different track that has to adapt to the bends and turns of your staircase. Typically, you can expect weight capacities between 300 lbs. and 350 lbs. for straight stairs and 265-300 lbs. for stairs that turn.

If your home has a straight staircase with about 12-14 steps, you should budget anywhere from \$2,000 to \$5,000 to purchase a new stair lift. Fit the stair lift seat in place. Stair lift seats come in either a fixed or swivel design. The seat is typically attached using screws at each of the four corners. Fit the seat on the frame and connect the seat control cables per manufacturer's instructions.
